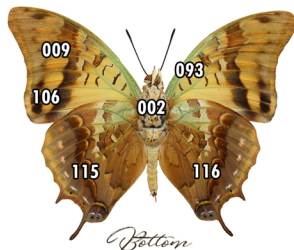
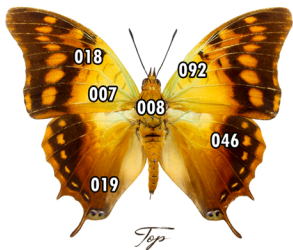


GRIZAYE DRAWING KIT COLOR GUIDE & TIPS

Green-Veined Butterfly

INFORMATION

The charaxes candiope, also known as green-veined emperor or green-veined charaxes, is part of the family Nymphalidae and is native to Sub-Saharan Africa. According to the Guinness World Record, they are the most aggressive butterfly in existence. They use their horns to intimidate predators, their serrated-edged wings to elbow their way to favorite feeding areas, and will dive-bomb anyone in their territory. These medium-sized butterflies have a wingspan up to 60mm with a flight period from October to June.

GRIZAYE TIPS

With this kit, we divided the top and bottom of the butterfly into six colors each. Still, you might want to borrow colors from the other palette, using the lightest color as a blender. Detailing all the veins first can help reserve your details. Mirroring your work from one wing to the next will assure continuity. Once complete, go back and darken your darks for a finished look. Cut the paper in half and mount to the 8x10" mat provided, add the backing, then just frame and hang. Good luck, and most of all, have fun!
